Sensory System 9:45am – 1pm *no crèche **Tuesday 25th April and 6th June 2017 (repeat)**

For parents of children with sensory difficulties and/or sensory processing disorder. The aim of this training is to provide parents with a clear picture of what sensory processing difficulties look like and strategies to try at home.

Understanding the Special Educational Needs (SEN) System 9:45am – 2:45pm, crèche available, lunch provided **Wednesday 21st June 2017**

This training covers the key principles of the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Code of Practice, focusing on the key aspects such as levels of provision in schools, setting targets, the statement and Education Health Care Plan process and annual reviews.

We will be looking at what this means in practice, what the Local Authority and schools have the duty to provide and what a parent/carer can expect.

This two day Makaton training will provide a practical introduction to Makaton signing. The signs taught will focus on positive and practical communication with your child.
