Positive Behaviour Management Part 1 and 2 9:45am – 2:45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Tuesday 26th September and 10th October 2017

Part 1 explores the importance of understanding behaviour before planning intervention strategies. The aim of the day is to equip participants with models for understanding and tools for assessing behaviour.

Part 2 looks at strategies and resources for promoting positive behaviour and managing challenging behaviour.

For parents of children with sensory difficulties and/or sensory processing disorder. The aim of this training is to provide parents with a clear picture of what sensory processing difficulties look like and strategies to try at home.

Understanding the Special Educational Needs (SEN) System 9:45am – 2:45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Wednesday 15th November 2017

This training covers the key principles of the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Code of Practice, focusing on the key aspects such as levels of provision in schools, setting targets, the statement and Education Health Care Plan process and annual reviews.

We will be looking at what this means in practice, what the Local Authority and schools have the duty to provide and what a parent/carer can expect.
