Understanding SEN System

Wednesday 17th January 2018

- Key principles of the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Code of Practice, covering levels of SEND provision in schools, setting targets, the Statement and Education Health Care Plan process and Annual Reviews.
- What the Local Authority and schools have the duty to provide and what a parent/carer can expect.

Writing SMART Outcomes for EHC Plan

Tuesday 23rd January 2018

- Using outcomes to plan all SEND Support and the key role of outcomes within SEND Statements or Education Health and Care Plans (EHCP).
- How to make outcomes SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound).
- Transfer and assessment process for EHCPs.

- For parents of children with sensory difficulties and/or sensory processing disorder to understand what the condition looks like.
- Facilitated by Occupational Therapists.
- Strategies to try at home to manage behaviour.
