- daytime and evening sessions for adults with learning disabilities.

**Minibus driving:** We especially welcome applicants who are able and willing to drive, and we will provide training on minibus driving.

### Hours and working pattern:

We are seeking to recruit a part-time worker who is available to work on specific sessions in term-times (36 weeks a year) on:

- **Monday** daytime adults arts session: 10.30am – 3.30pm
- **Tuesday & Thursday** children's after school clubs: 3.30 - 7pm
- **Friday** evening adults social club: 6.30 to 9.30pm

In addition to the above regular hours we can offer ad hoc sessions as cover, and work on our holiday playschemes.
