Sensory Needs, Behaviour and the Environment

Tuesday 2nd October and 4th December 2018 (repeat)

- For parents of children with sensory difficulties and/or sensory processing disorder to understand what the condition looks like.
- Facilitated by Haringey Occupational Therapists.
- Strategies to try at home to manage behaviour.

Communication Passport

Wednesday 26th September and 28th November 2018

A 'Communication Passport' is a way of sharing knowledge of how to meet your child's needs. This is a course for parents to help you to create one for your child. There is a £15 charge for you to create the finished Communication Passport book for you - which you can then take away to use at your child's school, afterschool clubs, holiday playschemes, etc

Writing SMART Outcomes for EHC Plans

- Using outcomes to plan all SEND Support and the key role of outcomes within SEND Education Health and Care Plans (EHCP).
- How to make outcomes SMART (Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, Time-bound).
- Transfer and assessment process for EHCPs.

Introduction to Makaton

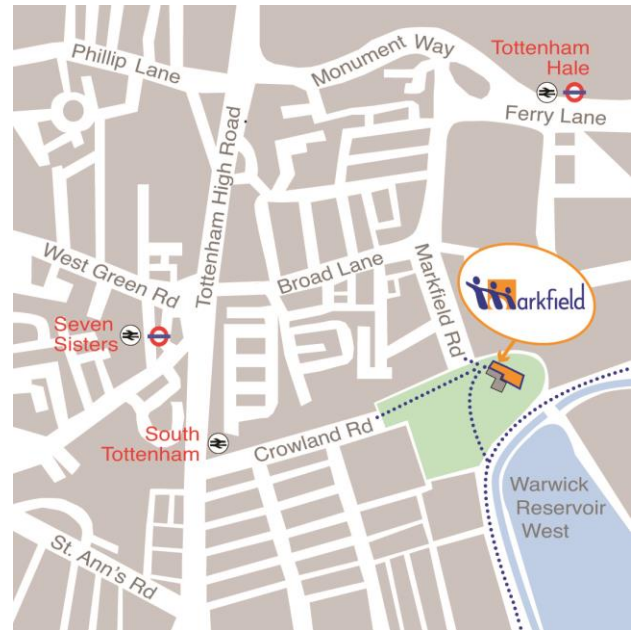
Walking: via Crowland Road and through Markfield Park (see map)
