Stepping Stones is a 10-week sensory play and language programme for families with children under the age of 5 with additional needs in communication,

social skills and language. It is designed to equip parents and carers with the skills and knowledge to confidently interact with their children through play and music

What is involved

This course runs over 10 weeks and has 4 steps

Week 1 We will need you to attend an introductory meeting to give you more information about the programme

Step 1 Weeks 2 to 9. Parents, carers and their children meet once a week, for 1 hour, every Thursday between 10.30am and 11.30am. This is followed by lunch and time to talk. You can also choose to stay on for our Inclusive Stay and Play session which runs until 2.30pm

Steps 2 and 3 are both held on Week 10. This involves a workshop to help you practise and run through the song and activity you have chosen to share, followed by the sharing event itself. This is held during our Inclusive Stay and Play session

Step 4 every term we also have a re-union meeting where parents and carers can continue to meet up to chat and try out new activities

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
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
