Sensory Needs, Behaviour and the

Environment 9:45am – 1pm *no crèche Tuesday 23rd April and 25th June 2019 (repeat)

- For parents of children with sensory difficulties and/or sensory processing disorder to understand what the condition looks like.
- Facilitated by Haringey Occupational Therapists.
- Strategies to try at home to manage behaviour.

Understanding Autism

9:45am – 2.45pm, crèche available, lunch provided For parents and carers of children under 10 years old: Wednesday 1st May 2019

- For parents who had fairly recent diagnosis of autism for their child.
- To discuss the autism diagnosis; learn more about autism and communication needs and understand access to support.
- Content for this training has been developed by the National Autistic Society.

Positive Behaviour Management Part 1 and 2

9:45am – 2.45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Wednesday 15th and 22nd May 2019

- Part 1 is about understanding behaviour to equip participants with models for understanding and tools for assessing behaviour.
- Part 2 looks at strategies and resources for promoting positive behaviour and managing challenging behaviour.

Understanding SEN System

9:45am – 2.45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Wednesday 12th June 2019

- Key principles of the Special Educational Needs and Disabilities (SEND) Code of Practice, covering levels of SEND provision in schools, setting targets, Education Health Care Plan process and Annual Reviews.
- What the Local Authority and schools have the duty to provide and what a parent/carer can expect.

Developmental Movement Play

9:45am – 2.45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Wednesday19th June 2019

- For parents and carers of children with communication difficulties to support sensory integration, communication skills and co-ordination.
- Being a positive communication role model and tackling unwanted behaviours.
- Demonstration and practice of play activities.

Introduction to Makaton

9:45am – 2.45pm, crèche available, lunch provided Wednesday 26st June 2019

A practical introduction to Makaton signing, focusing on positive and practical communication with your child.

For parents/carers of children or adults with additional needs in speech and language.

Communication Passport 9:45am – 1pm, *no crèche Wednesday 3rdth July

• A 'Communication Passport' is a way of sharing knowledge of how to meet your child's needs. This is a course for parents to help you to create one for your child - which you can then take away to use at your child's school, afterschool clubs, holiday playschemes, etc. There is a £15 charge for the book.
