About Markfield

Markfield is an inclusive community hub in Tottenham where people can play, socialise and get information and support. We run holiday schemes for children and young people, where they can relax, have fun and choose activities they enjoy.

Markfield's well-trained staff are experienced in including children and young people with a very wide range of needs and disabilities.

Activities & facilities at Markfield include

- Huge adventure playground with tunnels, dens, swings & slides, bonfire pit, sandpit and zip wire
- Arts, crafts, textile, music and gardening and cooking activities
- Trampoline, football and basketball
- Split level soft play room, large hall, fully
- accessible changing room
- Trips to local parks, bowling, cinema, et

We can provide mini-bus transport to and from Markfield (places are limited).



Cost of play scheme

the Local Authority.

Subsidised places

How to get to Markfield



The Markfield centre is in Markfield Park in South Tottenham, N15

Walking: go to the end of Markfield Road, under the bridge and into the Park, and follow the cobbled road. OR you can walk via Crowland Road through Markfield Park, OR via the River Lea towpath.

Driving: vehicle access is via Markfield Road. Parking is available next to the centre.
